HOW IS HEPATITIS A SPREAD?



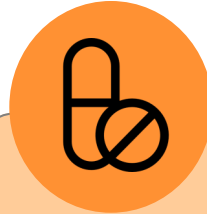
Not washing hands



Sex with infected partners

Recreational drug use

It can also be spread through close contact with someone infected with hepatitis A.

HOW DO I HELP PREVENT THE SPREAD OF HEPATITIS A?



Wash your hands with soap and water after using the bathroom and before eating and preparing food.



GET VACCINATED IF YOU ARE AT HIGH RISK FOR GETTING HEPATITIS A!

WHO IS AT HIGH RISK?

- People who use recreational drugs
- People who are currently homeless or in transient living
- Gay and bisexual men

If you are considered High Risk for contracting Hepatitis A, you are eligible to receive free Hepatitis A vaccine at any of our Health Department locations Monday-Friday from 8am-4pm.
