STEP ONE 209-8090

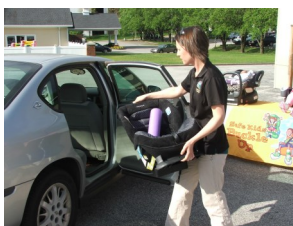
A Health Department and Regional Health Council initiative designed to address the problem of obesity among residents by promoting good nutrition and active living (Optimize with Nutrition & Exercise).

HEALTH PLANNING AND ASSESSMENT 209-8093

Collects and analyzes community health data for the purpose of monitoring the health status of residents in Hamilton County.

HEALTH PROMOTION AND WELLNESS 209-8242

Health educators provide evidence-based health promotion programs. Topics include highway safety, tobacco prevention and education, personal safety, and chronic disease prevention.



ENVIRONMENTAL HEALTH SERVICES

FOOD/GENERAL SANITATION 209-8110

Inspects restaurants, hotels and motels, public swimming pools, day care/camps, and tattoo establishments. Investigates general sanitation complaints (garbage, open dumps, high grass).



RABIES PROGRAM 209-8110

Controls the spread of rabies within Hamilton County. All animal bites should be reported to the Environmental Health Office.

ADMINISTRATIVE SERVICES

EMERGENCY PREPAREDNESS 209-8074

Coordinates planning and response efforts related to a public health disaster or emergency.

VITAL RECORDS 209-8025

Obtain copies of birth and death certificates and voluntary acknowledgement of paternity, (VAoP).

MEDICAL RECORDS 209-8209

Retains Health Department records for up to ten years after the last visit. Copies can be obtained for a fee.

CASE MANAGEMENT SERVICES

COMMUNITY OUTREACH 209-8080

Promotes and oversees checkups for children covered under TENNCare from birth to age 21.

HUGS (HELP US GROW SUCCESSFULLY) 209-8080

Provides home-based prevention and intervention services for pregnant and postpartum women.

CHILDREN SPECIAL SERVICES 209-8080

Ensures children with special medical needs receive appropriate, comprehensive and timely services.

PARENTS ARE FIRST TEACHERS 209-8080

Teaches parenting skills to Hamilton County parents who have children, prenatal to age 5.

WELCOME BABY 209-8391

Connects infants and families with appropriate services, provides referrals, and screenings.

INFANT MORTALITY REDUCTION INITIATIVE 209-8135

Assess infant and birth data and infant mortality rates. Collaborate with partners to identify issues and develop solutions to improve birth outcomes.

HIV/RYAN WHITE ASSISTANCE 209-8272

Provides eligibility, social support, and resources to those living with HIV/AIDS in Hamilton County.

COMMUNITY ASSISTANCE SERVICES 209-8375

Emergency Assistance Program aims to prevent homeless by providing temporary assistance to Hamilton County residents experiencing a financial crisis.

NEWBORN GENETIC SCREENING 209-8080

Follow up retesting and resources.

CLINICAL SERVICES

IMMUNIZATIONS (3RD STREET)

Infants/children/adolescents- Child Health Clinic, 209-8050
Adult (age 19 +) - Adult Clinic, 209-8340
International Travel - 209-8340
Call Additional Clinic Locations on back for availability & appointments.

STD CLINIC 209-8250

Provides diagnostic testing for HIV and treatment for sexually transmitted diseases.

EPIDEMIOLOGY 209-8190

Tracks the occurrence and controls the spread of reportable disease in Hamilton County through community education and data gathering, analysis, and preventative medications.

TUBERCULOSIS CONTROL 209-8030

Conducts TB skin testing and chest x-rays. Manages and treats latent TB infection and TB cases.

DENTAL SERVICES 209-8100

Provides preventive and routine care for children. Limited adult care is provided.



TN BREAST & CERVICAL

CANCER SCREENING 209-8009

Eligible women can receive free services. Clinical screenings of the breast and cervix include complete breast exam, mammogram referrals, pelvic exam, and pap screenings.

PRIMARY CARE

Provides sick care for those with illness-related symptoms who may need exams, tests, and treatment, as well as those seeking wellness and preventative care. Available at Birchwood (adult and child) and Sequoyah (child only) clinics (see back for phone numbers).

WIC NUTRITIONAL SUPPLEMENT PROGRAM INFO 209-8220

Supplemental nutrition program for women who are pregnant, postpartum, and/or breastfeeding and infants and children up to age 5.

CHILD HEALTH 209-8050 FOR 3RD ST. LOCATION (OR CALL CLINIC OF CHOICE ON BACK)

Promotes child health through physicals, hearing and vision screenings, laboratory testing, physical assessments, and immunizations.



FAMILY PLANNING 209-8050 FOR 3RD ST. LOCATION (OR CALL CLINIC OF CHOICE ON BACK)

Pregnancy testing on a walk-in basis and birth control by appointment. Provides counseling and education on family planning.

BREASTFEEDING SUPPORT 209-8321

All things breastfeeding for pregnant and breastfeeding moms.



HOMELESS HEALTH CARE CLINIC 265-5708

Diagnosis and treatment of acute and chronic illnesses, mental health and substance abuse evaluation and treatment, assistance with entitlement programs for homeless individuals.
