AN ACT to amend Tennessee Code Annotated, Title 53, Chapter 8, Part 2; Title 68, Chapter 14, Part 3; Title 68, Chapter 14, Part 7 and Chapter 182 of the Public Acts of 2013, relative to temporary food service establishments.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE:

SECTION 1. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 68-14-302, is amended by deleting subdivision (15) in its entirety and by substituting instead the following:

(15) "Temporary food service establishment" means a food service establishment that operates at a fixed location in conjunction with an organized temporary event for more than one (1) day and not more than fourteen (14) consecutive days.

SECTION 2. Chapter 182 of the Public Acts of 2013, is amended in § 68-14-703 of SECTION 45 by deleting subdivision (14) in its entirety and by substituting instead the following:

(14) "Temporary food service establishment" means a food service establishment that operates at a fixed location in conjunction with an organized temporary event for more than one (1) day and not more than fourteen (14) consecutive days.

SECTION 3. Section 1 of this act shall take effect upon becoming a law, the public welfare requiring it. Section 2 of this act shall take effect at 12:01 a.m. on July 1, 2015, the public welfare requiring it.
