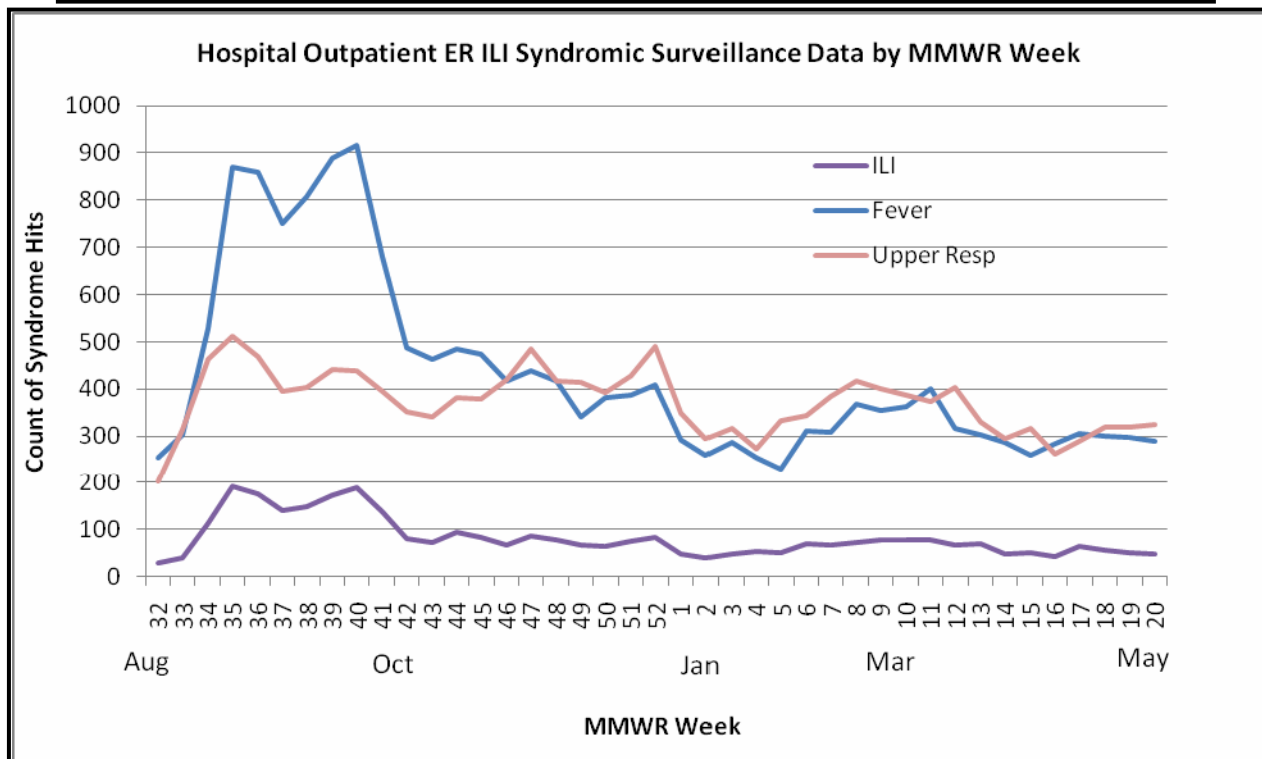
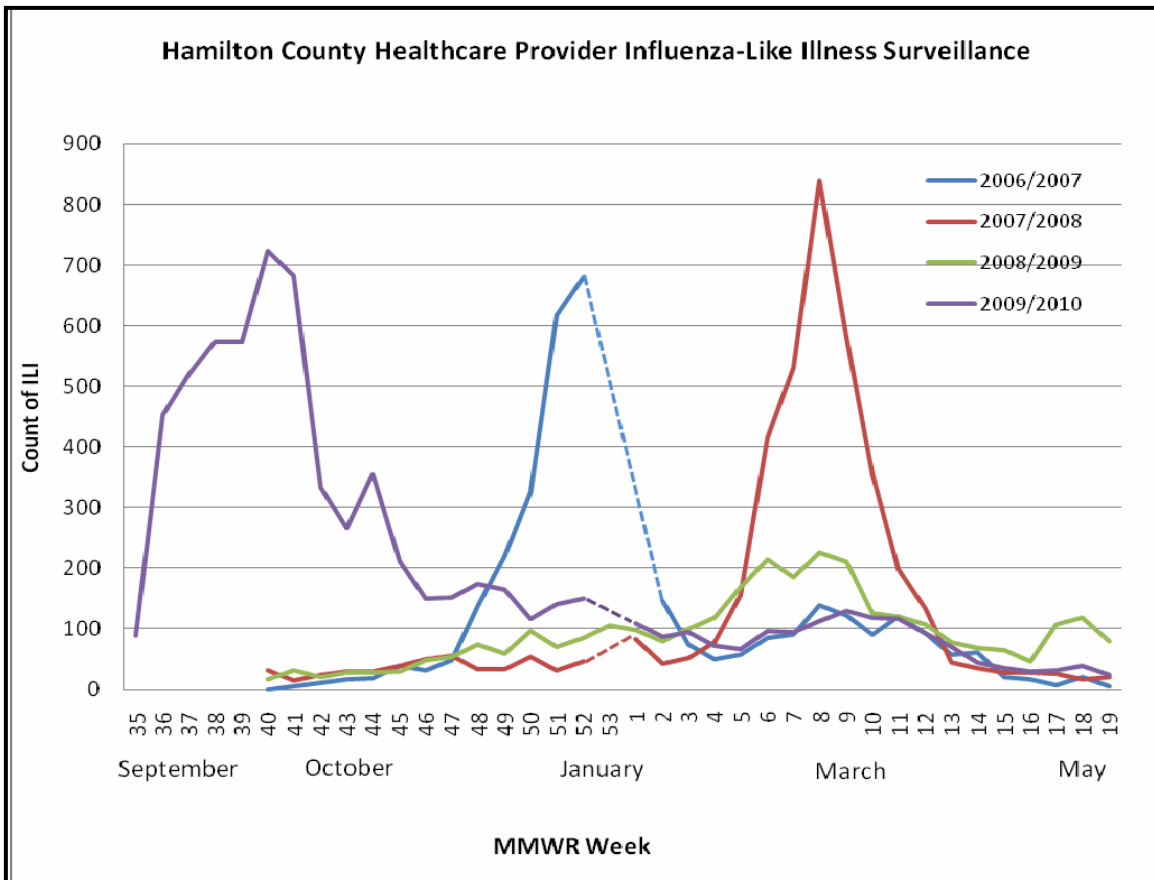




Influenza Surveillance Graphs
