Health Department to Offer Vital Records and Immunization Records Free of Charge

Many people across Hamilton County have experienced devastating losses as a result of last week's tornados and storms. In an effort to make the recovery process as easy as possible for Hamilton County residents impacted by the storm, the Chattanooga-Hamilton County Health Department is making available free copies of vital records and immunization records.

Residents who have lost these records due to the disaster may obtain free, certified birth and death certificates at the Chattanooga-Hamilton County Health Department located at 921 E. 3rd Street.

Certified copies of birth certificates are available for any birth in Tennessee which occurred from 1949 to date. Death certificates are available for deaths occurring in Hamilton County from 2005 to date. Residents needing records not available at the Hamilton County office can call (615) 741-1763 or go online at <http://health.state.tn.us/Vr>. In addition, the requirement to provide photo identification is also being temporarily waived for those persons who have lost all identification.
