## **Health Department Has Booked All Available Appointments for H1N1 Injectable Vaccine – Continues to Make Appointments for H1N1 FluMist Vaccine**

Chattanooga, TN- The Chattanooga-Hamilton County Health Department has booked appointments for all of the 1,300 doses of injectable 2009 H1N1 vaccine received. The Health Department anticipates getting more injectable vaccine in the future, but does not have an expected delivery date at this time.

The public is encouraged to continue to make appointments for the H1N1 FluMist since shipments of this formulation continue to be received. We encourage all healthy, non-pregnant individuals between the ages of 2 and 49 to protect themselves and their families from H1N1 by making an appointment for the FluMist vaccine,” stated Health Department Health Officer, Dr. Valerie Boaz.

FluMist appointments can be made by calling the Health Department’s hotline at 209-8393, Monday – Friday between the hours of 8:30 am and 4:00 pm. Appointments are available at Eastgate, Sequoyah Health Center and Ooltewah Health Center for the FluMist formulation.

The H1N1 flu vaccine is being provided at no charge. The Health Department will continue to announce future H1N1 vaccination clinics and vaccine shipments through the media, our website, [health.hamiltontn.org](http://health.hamiltontn.org), and our Twitter account- @HamiltonHealth.
