Health Department Offers Free Flu Shots at Alstom Today & Wednesday from 1:30-5:00PM

HAMILTON COUNTY, TN – The Hamilton County Health Department is extending the number of flu vaccine drive-thru days at Alstom this week from two days to three. Free flu vaccinations for Hamilton County adults will be available this Tuesday and Wednesday (October 20 and 21) from 1:30-5:00PM at the Alstom Plant, 1125 Riverfront Pkwy, Chattanooga, TN 37402.

- This is a drive-through clinic for Hamilton County residents only at this time.
- No appointment is needed.
- Face masks will be required for all persons in their vehicle during the vaccination process.
- This is the same location as the COVID-19 testing site.
