


What to Know About Hepatitis A

- People who use recreational drugs
 People who are currently
- Gay and bisexual men

People who are currently
 homeless or in transient living

If you are considered High Risk for contracting Hepatitis A, you are eligible to receive free

Hepatitis A vaccine at any of our Health Department locations Monday-Friday from 8am-4pm.
