A smoking cessation program for pregnant and postpartum women.

Chronic Disease Prevention (423) 209-8058

Preventing chronic diseases by promoting health and wellness activities.

Community Outreach (423) 209-8249

Bringing public health education and vaccines to residents within the community.

Highway Safety (423) 209-8204

Programs to provide car seats and traffic related education.

Overdose Prevention (423) 209-8317

Preventing substance misuse and overdoses.

Step ONE (423) 209-8088

An initiative to address obesity among residents by promoting good nutrition and active living.

Tobacco Prevention (423) 209-8203

Preventing tobacco use in the community.

Violence Prevention (423) 209-8285

Empowers communities to prevent sexual violence and promote personal safety.

Regional Health Council (423) 209-8088

Responsible for community health assessment, regional health planning and the provision of input regarding health related initiatives.

Environmental Health

Food/General Sanitation (423) 209-8110

Inspects restaurants, hotels and motels, public swimming pools, day care/camps, and tattoo establishments. Investigates general sanitation complaints (garbage, open dumps, high grass).

Rabies Program (423) 209-8110

Controls the spread of rabies within Hamilton County. All animals bites should be reported to the Environmental Health Office.

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Administrative Services

Emergency Preparedness (423) 209-8074

Coordinates planning and response efforts related to a public health emergency or disaster.

Medical Records (423) 209-8209

Retains Health Department records for ten years after the last visit. Copies can be obtained for a fee.

Vital Records (423) 209-8025

Obtain copies of birth and death certificates, cremation permits and voluntary acknowledgement of paternity (VAoP).



Childhood Lead Poisoning Prevention (423) 209-8080

Strengthen blood lead testing in children, linking exposed children to services and providing medical case management and care coordination.

Community Assistance Services (423) 209-8375

Assistance program aims to prevent homelessness by providing temporary assistance to Hamilton County residents experiencing a financial crisis.

Community Health Access Navigation in Tennessee (CHANT) (423) 209-8080

Provides patient-centered engagement, navigation of medical and social service referrals and have a positive impact on pregnancy, children and health outcomes.

Fetal Infant Mortality Review (423) 209-8135

Assess infant and birth data and infant mortality rates. Collaborate with partners to identify issues and develop solutions to improve birth outcomes.

Ryan White Case Management (423) 209-8272

Provides medical case management, eligibility, social support and resources to those living with HIV/AIDS.

Newborn Screenings (423) 209-8080

Ensures appropriate care and medical follow up occurs for infants and children that have failed a newborn hearing or genetic testing screen.

Parents as Teachers (423) 209-8298

Home visiting program that provides parenting education, information, developmental screenings and activities to parents to assist them in the growth and development of children.

Clinical Services

Child Health (423) 209-8050

Provides healthcare for ages 0-18 through physical assessment, hearing and vision screenings, lab testing, and immunizations. Services at 3rd Street, Birchwood, Ooltewah and Sequoyah.



Dental Services (423) 209-8100

Provides preventive and routine care for children. Limited adult care is provided. Services at 3rd Street, Ooltewah and Sequoyah.

Epidemiology (423) 209-8190

Prevents and controls the spread of reportable communicable diseases through data gathering and analysis, provider collaboration, education and preventative medications.

Homeless Health (423) 209-5800

Provides medical, dental, behavioral health and case management services for homeless and transient individuals. Located downtown area.

Family Planning (423) 209-8350

Pregnancy testing on a walk-in basis and birth control by appointment. Provides counseling and education on family planning.

Immunizations (call clinic of choice)

Provides CDC recommended vaccinations for children and adults.

- Child Health at 3rd St (ages 0-18 years)
- Adult Immunizations (age 19 and up) are available in the Travel & Adult Immunization Clinic
- All ages at Birchwood, Ooltewah and Sequoyah.

Sexual Health Clinic (423) 209-8250

Provides diagnostic testing, treatment and prevention of sexually transmitted diseases; testing and referral for HIV and Hepatitis C. Services at 3rd Street campus.

TN Breast & Cervical Cancer Screening (423) 209-8009

Clinical screenings of the breast and cervix include complete breast exam, mammogram referrals, pelvic exam and pap smear. Free services for eligible women.

Travel & Adult Immunization Clinic (423) 209-8340

Provides consultation and administers required and recommended travel vaccines for all ages. Provides routine adult (age 19 and up) immunizations.

Primary Care (Call Clinic of Choice)

Provides general health care for preventative and illness-related symptoms including wellness exams, lab testing, assessment and treatment for illnesses. Services at Birchwood (children and adults), Homeless (children and adults) and Sequoyah (children) health clinics.

Tuberculosis (TB) Clinic (423) 209-8030

Provides testing, diagnosis and treatment of TB. Services at 3rd Street campus.

WIC Nutritional Program (423) 209-8220

Educational and supplemental nutrition program for women who are pregnant, postpartum and/or breastfeeding and infants and children up to age 5 years. Services at 3rd Street, Birchwood, Ooltewah and Sequoyah health clinics.
