

Hamilton County COVID-19 Vaccination Reporting

Tennessee Department of Health (TDH) allocates vaccine supplies to health care systems, clinics and pharmacies that have enrolled to provide vaccine. All data is from the Tennessee Immunization Information System (TennIIS). Providers administering COVID-19 vaccines are expected to report vaccine doses to TennIIS within 24 hours of administration and are required to report doses no later than 72 hours of administration. **Due to this reporting lag, data is preliminary and subject to change.**

The following charts display the percentages of the population who are at least partially vaccinated in three different forms; overall population, age group and race & ethnicity. The charts are interactive and display the proportion of the population at least partially vaccinated over time. As you hover over a specific date, the data appears in a key over the chart corresponding to the color of each line. These three charts only display data for Hamilton County residents. As stated above, **all data is preliminary and subject to change** as vaccination records continue to be updated in TennIIS.

The demographic table below has been updated to show Hamilton County **resident** data. Doses administered to those who do not reside in Hamilton County and have traveled here for vaccination are not reflected. The demographic table includes a population estimate for each category, the count of individuals who are at least partially vaccinated, as well as a percentage of that specific category who are at least partially vaccinated. Population estimates are based on the US Census Bureau 2019: American Community Survey (ACS) 1-Year Estimates for demographics. An individual's demographics are only counted **once** and are not recorded a second time.

Data is limited to sex, age, race, and ethnicity. Race is self-reported by the individual. For those reported as 'unknown' or 'other' in the categories of sex, race and ethnicity, a count is shown without a percent of overall population vaccinated.
