The Live Well-Age Well Program promotes healthy lifestyle choices for older adults through interactive presentations and evidence-based programs.

Overdose Prevention (423) 209-8317

Preventing substance misuse and overdoses through education and partnerships.

Regional Health Council (423) 209-8088

Responsible for community health assessment, regional health planning and the provision of input regarding health related initiatives.

Educational programs to support healthy lifestyles for residents.

Tobacco Prevention (423) 209-8203

Preventing tobacco use in the community through education.

Traffic & Pedestrian Safety (423) 209-8204

Programs to provide car seats and traffic related education.

Violence Prevention (423) 209-8285

The Sexual Violence Prevention program uses a public health approach to prevent domestic and dating violence, sexual harassment, and human trafficking.

Environmental Health

Food/General Sanitation (423) 209-8110

Inspects restaurants, hotels, motels, public swimming pools, day cares, camps, bed and breakfasts, and tattoo and piercing establishments. Investigates general sanitation complaints in the county (garbage, open dumps, high grass).

Rabies Program (423) 209-8110

Controls the spread of rabies within Hamilton County. All animal bites should be reported to the Environmental Health Office.

Administrative Services

Emergency Preparedness (423) 209-8074

Coordinates planning and response efforts related to a public health emergency or disaster.

Medical Records (423) 209-8209

Retains Health Department records for ten years after the last visit. Copies can be obtained for a fee.

Vital Records (423) 209-8025

Provides copies of Tennessee birth and death certificates, cremation permits and voluntary acknowledgement of paternity (VAoP).



Case Management

Childhood Lead Poisoning Prevention (423) 209-8080

Strengthen blood lead testing in children, linking exposed children to services and providing medical case management and care coordination.

Community Assistance Services (423) 209-8374

Assistance program aims to prevent homelessness by providing temporary assistance to Hamilton County residents experiencing a financial crisis.

Community Health Access Navigation in Tennessee (CHANT) (423) 209-8080

Provides patient-centered engagement, navigation of medical and social service referrals to promote a positive impact on pregnancy, children and health outcomes.

Epidemiology (423) 209-8190

Prevents and controls the spread of reportable communicable diseases through data gathering and analysis, provider collaboration, education and preventative medications.

Fetal Infant Mortality Review (423) 209-8135

Collaborates with partners to identify issues and develop solutions to improve birth outcomes.

Newborn Screenings (423) 209-8050

Ensures appropriate care and medical follow up for infants and children that have failed a newborn hearing or genetic testing screen.

Parents as Teachers (423) 209-8298

Home visiting program that provides parenting education, information, developmental screenings and activities to parents to assist them in the growth and development of children.

Ryan White Medical Case Management (423) 209-8272

Provides medical case management, eligibility, social support and resources to those living with HIV/AIDS.

Clinical Services

Child Health (423) 209-8050

Provides healthcare for ages 0-18 through lab testing and immunizations. Services at 3rd Street, Birchwood and Ooltewah..

Dental Services (423) 209-8100

Provides preventive and routine care for children. Limited adult care is provided. Services at 3rd Street and Homeless Health Clinic.

Homeless Health (423) 209-5800

Provides medical, dental, behavioral health, and case management services for individuals and families facing homelessness.

Immunizations (call clinic of choice)

Provides CDC recommended vaccinations for children and adults.

- Child Health at 3rd Street (ages 0-18 years)
- Adult Immunizations (age 19 and up) in the Travel & Adult Immunization Clinic
- All ages at Birchwood and Ooltewah.

Sexual & Reproductive Wellness Clinic (423) 209-8350

Provides diagnostic testing, treatment and prevention of sexually transmitted diseases; testing and referral for HIV and Hepatitis C. Services at 3rd Street campus. Pregnancy testing on a walk-in basis and birth control by appointment. Provides counseling and education on family planning.

Presumptive TennCare/ Cover Kids Assistance Program (423) 209-8133

Provides assistance with either immediate, temporary TennCare coverage or CoverKids Insurance for eligible pregnant women.

TN Breast & Cervical Cancer Screening (423) 209-8009

Clinical screenings of the breast and cervix include complete breast exam, mammogram referrals, pelvic exam and pap smear. Free services for eligible women.

Travel & Adult Immunization Clinic (423) 209-8340

Provides consultation and administers required and recommended travel vaccines for all ages . Provides routine adult (age 19 and up) immunizations .

Tuberculosis (TB) Clinic (423) 209-8030

Provides testing, diagnosis and treatment of TB. Services at 3rd Street campus.
